"Since December, the warming bus, staffed by St. Matthew's House outreach workers and driven by HSR operators, has typically picked up between 20 and 30 riders a night, the social-service agency says.

The homeless-serving bus is nearing the end of its inaugural season as part of the city's expanded December-though-March winter response program. It was launched amid an enduring homelessness crisis that has packed shelters and left parks dotted with tents.

It has offered a rolling safe space where people can warm up, grab some shuteye, and have a snack and drink under the supervision of trained staff."
